- 1. A candidate must be a bonafide student of Govt. Aizawl College
- 2. No student shall be allowed to contest the post of General Secretary and Vice President unless he/she is a 5th Semester student.
- 3. No repeaters shall be allowed to file for election to any office of the Students' Union.
- 4. Students who have been holding any office of the Students' Union for two consecutive terms shall not be allowed to contest in the election for the same post.
- 5. Candidates and their supporters should not disturb the normal functioning of the classes and house-to-house campaigning is strictly prohibited.
- 6. A candidate will be disqualified if he/she gets the help of outsiders including outgoing students as campaigners.
- 7. Sticking poster on the walls of the college building, Govt. Primary School and Middle School is not allowed. Any poster found on these walls will be removed by the authority.
- 8. Casting of votes will be conducted through secret ballot paper.
- 9. Candidates must have completed at least one academic year of the study in the College.
- 10. Candidates must not be active members of any political party, regional or national.

- 1. Violation of any of the above instructions will result in the cancellation of candidates.
- 2. Returning Officer and Asst. Returning Officer's decision and finding in matters relating to S.U. Election will be final and binding.
