ACTIONS TAKEN ON STAKEHOLDERS' FEEDBACK 2023-2024

Stakeholder feedbacks were collected by the Curricular Aspects Cell on behalf of the IQAC during the Academic Year 2023-2024. Faculty members, students, parents, alumni and employers of alumni were surveyed to find out how these diverse groups of stakeholders perceive the College. The feedback received was analyzed and reviewed and the following actions have been taken accordingly.

1. STUDENTS' FEEDBACK ON COURSE AND TEACHERS

The feedback survey was conducted online among present students. The questions asked were regarding the quality of the present course content and their evaluation of teacher performances. Responses were received from students of all 9 departments. The students were also asked to rate their teachers on 10 criteria points as shown below:

- 1. Knowledge base of the teacher
- 2. Communication Skills
- 3. Sincerity/Commitment of the teacher
- 4. Interest generated by the teacher in the class
- 5. Ability to integrate course material with environment
- 6. Accessibility and availability of the teacher in the College for academicconsultations
- 7. Initiative taken in formulating topics/tests etc.
- 8. Regularity in taking class
- 9. Completion of the course/subject in thorough and satisfactory manner
- 10. Fairness in evaluating performance and awarding grade

To maintain confidentiality of the feedback, the analysis and individual scores were intimated to the respective teachers and a copy of the summary was submitted to the Principal for necessary action.

2. TEACHERS' FEEDBACK

Feedback was solicited from the faculty members of all departments. The questions were regarding course content and delivery, availability of books, research opportunities, etc.

3. PARENTS' FEEDBACK

Feedback was solicited from the parents/guardians of the current students. To ensure

clarity, the vernacular version of the questions was included with the English version as majority of the respondents were Mizo.

4. ALUMNI FEEDBACK

The alumni also provided their valuable feedback, responding with candid and positive responses.

5. EMPLOYERS' FEEDBACK

Feedback was solicited from the employers of students who have graduated from the College.
